Background:

- Harrison Dunbar, leads on vocals, writes and produces all songs. Age 19 from Tunbridge Wells, Kent.
 - Now at Loughborough Uni studying Robotics (finished first year of 4) juggling studies with writing, producing and gigging.
- Milo Fahey, kick-ass female drummer, brings energy to live shows. Age 18 from Tonbridge, Kent.
 - Finished A-levels and getting ready to throw herself into gigging!
- Where it started:
 - Harrison plays keys, drums and some guitar, with a broad interest in music of all genres. He's even an excellent House DJ, and a big fan of The Prodigy.
 - During covid lockdown turned to online lessons in professional electronic music production in Ableton (then age just 14/15) which he did for 2 years, earning a professional certification.
 - Through drumming Harrison acquired a taste for harder metal genres, and discovered hardcore experimental bands like Machine Girl.
 - Having been a drummer in a previous band, he wanted to front a band and created a metal band with local friends, which quickly started to get traction. But the sound was not what Harrison was searching for, and he started writing tracks for a new project RIOTCANDY, blending electronic with punk and hardcore, which soon became the main focus.
 - Knowing he needed something extra for live shows he approached Milo at an open mic night at The Forum in Tunbridge Wells, where she had been drumming solo to Nirvana. He was blown away with her talent and asked her to join RIOTCANDY. After hearing a few sample tracks, she quickly accepted. The two artists complement each other and the chemistry on stage just works.
 - Their first gig was another open mic which was a huge success and spurred them on to release their first album and music video "Deadstar" in 2025. They were quickly invited to headline a big local festival and their own headline show back at The Forum which was a sell-out 250 crowd.

Band Bio:

RIOTCANDY is a high energy, digi-punk mix of electronic hardcore rave, nu-metal and breakbeat (even some rap and hip-hop), all with live vocals and drums. With diverse influences from the likes of The Prodigy, Machine Girl, and Jane Remover.

RIOTCANDY are known for their intensity and high energy crowds. Born in response to an increasingly disorienting world, RIOTCANDY is the pulse of a hyper-stimulated generation; fast, melodic, and emotionally charged.

Frontman Harrison writes, produces, and designs the music, bringing the vision of RIOTCANDY into the real world.

On drums, Milo is a core part of the bands live structure and energy. Consistently bringing the heat and perfectly resonating with the raw, unfiltered passion of Harrison's vocal performance, their chemistry as a duo is what brings RIOTCANDY its unmistakable edge. RIOTCANDY's live performances never disappoint!

Where are they now:

- Since finishing A-levels and uni exams the focus is back on gigging and releasing more tracks and videos.
- RIOTCANDY are releasing their second album in August 2026, featuring huge new singles and their second official music video for the track "Monster Energy" (July 17th). Teaser for Monster Energy [Link here](#)
- In April 2026 RIOTCANDY supported The Prodigy's #1 tribute band Jilted Generation. The sell-out 250 crowd all turned up for their 45 min set which was a huge success. Jilted have now invited RIOTCANDY to open for more shows across the UK.
- They have been invited back to Local & Live to headline the opening night at The Forum, Friday 28th August.
